Q- Why did Amarin file a registration statement for a shelf offering on Feb 26, 2020?

A- The shelf offering that <u>Amarin filed on February 26, 2020</u> was a standard corporate housekeeping matter consistent with industry practice and Amarin's past practice. Shareholders should expect a similar filing every three years. This filing replaces the expiring shelf from March 2017, as noted in the <u>EXPLANATORY NOTE on page 3</u> of the filing:

As of the date of this Registration statement, Amarin is currently eligible to offer securities under its Registration Statement on Form S-3 filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 1, 2017 and automatically effective upon filing, or the Existing S-3. The Existing S-3 will expire and no longer be available for use by Amarin on March 1, 2020. This Registration Statement will in essence, beyond March 1, 2020, become a replacement for that expiring registration statement.
